

Jasper Rouwen (b.1997 in UK)

Based in Amsterdam (NL)
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Artist Bio:

Through painting, video, and installation, Jasper Rouwen researches the human necessity of control while exploring its impact on love and connection. How does our desire for security, order and safety affect our ability to connect and love when too much leads to stagnation and too little leads to chaos? By investigating the domestication of animals, regulatory signs used to guide and restrict human behaviour, and landscape modification, Rouwen seeks to create an alternative understanding of our desire for control. His works are traces of a mystery, symbolic equations allowing others to interpret and disrupt the cycle of questions and answers, appetite and satisfaction.

Born and raised in the UK, Jasper moved to the Netherlands in 2018 to start a BA in Fine Arts at the Gerrit Rietveld Academie, where he graduated in 2022. Since then, he has continued to live and work as an artist in Amsterdam, exhibiting at Galerie Ernst (2022), Rotterdam Art Week (2024) and most recently at spudWorks (2024), funded by the Arts Council England, where he displayed the culmination of the New Forest National Park Residency program. In 2022, together with Emile Weisz, he co-founded 'suzi', a curatorial initiative centred around exhibiting contemporary and experimental artists; their next show 'suzi IRL', is scheduled to take place in 2025 at Loods6.
